<b>Level 2</b> (Skate Canada Categories: <b>Juvenile</b> )	Cannot be 15 as of July 1, 2010	Skater must have passed at least one complete Jr. Bronze test (skill, set of dances or F/S)	Working on Sr. Bronze tests or higher	April 15, 22 & 29, 2010 5:00 – 6:50 pm Nichols Arena
<b>Level 3</b> (Skate Canada Categories: <b>Pre-Novice, Novice</b> )	Must be 10 years old before July 1, 2010 - Cannot be 19 years as of July 1, 2010	Skater has passed <u>1 complete</u> Senior Bronze test (F/S or skills or dance or interpretive)	Working on Jr. Silver tests or higher	April 15, 22 & 29, 2009 6:00 – 7:50 pm Nichols Arena
<b>Level 4</b> (Skate Canada Categories: <b>Intermediate, Open</b> )	Must be 12 years or older as of July 1, 2010	Must have passed at least <u>1 complete</u> Jr. Silver test (F/S or skills or dance or interpretive)	Working on Jr. Silver tests, Sr. Silver tests or working on or passed 1 complete Gold test	April 15, 22 & 29, 2009 7:00 – 8:50 pm Nichols Arena

Please Note:

- ✓ Out of club skaters welcome
- ✓ Skaters should come out to the level that matches **both** their age and test passed
- ✓ If a skater does not meet both age and test level, then they should go to their age category
- ✓ Coaches will move/assign skaters as necessary
- ✓ Skaters may have to show proof of tests passed
- ✓ It is expected that all skaters must skate at least one day with their home club, unless they have completed their Sr. Silver or Gold tests
- ✓ More try-outs may be held in the case of new skaters moving to the area
- ✓ Adult I, II, & III are separate audition dates and times
