Competitive Skating Update

Many individuals have done well this year representing the London Skating Club throughout the year. Watch for the next newsletter for a year ending wrap-up detailing how each skater did during the season.

Off to the Provincial Championships sponsored by Boston Pizza are the following skaters that either Home with the London Skating Club or skate an significant amount on LSC sessions: Brittaney Everett, George Tzortzis and Rebecca Jackson.

The Pre-juvenile team got 3rd place at the Bernie Deveau competition at the beginning of February in St. Thomas. The team has been asked to skate and represent the club on New Day, the morning program at A channel on March 8th. The theme of the skate is Pirates of the Caribbean. Way-to-go, Team!! We are very proud of you and how you represent the LSC.

Synchronized Skating Team News

The Skaters have represented LSC very well over the past two months.

- Our youngest team the pre-juvenile, had their very first competition on Feb. 2 in St. Thomas. This team finished close to the bottom last year and this year was 4th out of 9 teams after their first skate. They were extremely happy with this placing; however they ended up capturing the bronze medal and were ecstatic! They have one more competition in March.
- The juvenile team has had quite a year. They were judged for the first time ever with the new system, implemented at the Regional competition in North Bay. This is a very competitive category as we are competing against the top teams in all of Ontario. Earlier in the season this team finished in 7th and 8th place. They were crossing their fingers to perhaps move up to a 6th place finish at Regional's. They were very excited when they exceeded their expectations and finished 4th. They were actually 3rd in the second skate. They have gone on to win Gold at the Bernie Deveau competition.
- The Junior team was kept alive with the addition of 3 Open Girls who double teamed. This was to be mainly a development year but this team exceeded all expectations. They won a bronze medal at the Lloyd Olgilvie competition as well as representing London with rave reviews at a London Knights Hockey Game.
- The Open team has been working extremely hard on and off the ice. The Managers have been working non-stop as well to help fund the \$10,000 trip to Nationals in Chicoutimi, Quebec. They had their first taste of the new judging system at Regional's winning the bronze medal and made a huge improvement scoring 37 points higher than they received at Nationals last year. They are very optimistic and would love to bring home some hardware from Nationals. This team will be representing London at the Gala as well as the Old Timers Hockey Game on Tuesday Feb. 20, 7:00 pm at the JLC and then they leave directly for Quebec.
- All of our teams have raised the bar this year which was our goal. They have all won medals and as one parent put it "we are on a roll" lets continue the momentum. We hope to implement more stroking next year through our fundraising. I also have to mention Andrea Clement, who not only helps with the pre-juvenile team, runs their off-ice and does an amazing job with the synchro portion of the website. She along with many other Managers and parents has helped to make this season such a success. Everyone is welcome to come out and watch the teams skate on Sunday March 4 from 1:15 2:05 "C" Pad at Nichols arena.

Credit Policy Due To A Skating Injury

Injuries are never fun, but when a skater misses a significant amount of time, it can also result in a significant amount of skating sessions being paid for but not used by the skater. Even though most other sports will not issue a credit or refund if an athlete is injured during a season, regardless of the reason or how the athlete is injured, the London Skating Club has decided that it is in the best interest of the Club and families if we offer some credit in the unfortunate event of an injury as the result of skating takes place on LSC sessions. The credit is not 100% as there are costs that the club incurs regardless, but there is a credit just the same. As such, the board passed a resolution to establish formally the credit policy in the event of an injury to the skater.

Any skater that misses four or more consecutive weeks due to a London Skating Club on ice injury, and supplies a doctors note to the ice convener for the level they are currently skating that indicates the injury is the result of the on ice activity and proves the injury occurred during a LSC session, is entitled to a credit of 50% of the prorated amount of the session amount missed. This policy is effective February 13, 2007.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding this new policy, please submit your question or concern in writing to the LSC office by the end of March 13, 2007.
